THE PERMIT ALLOWS: Stabilisation works including installation of retaining walls, rock armours, rockfall netting and soil nails, in accordance with the following documents, as endorsed by the Executive Director Heritage Victoria and forming part of this permit:

Ongoing Program of Works - Summary of Proposed Works prepared by Department of Transport

THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS APPLY TO THIS PERMIT:

- 1. The permission granted for this permit must expire if one of the following circumstances applies: the permitted works have not commenced within two (2) years of the original date of issue of this permit, or are not completed within four (4) years of the original date of issue of this permit.
- 2. The Executive Director Heritage Victoria is to be given five working days' notice of the intention to commence the approved works.
- 3. Twelve (12) months after determination of this permit, and every twelve (12) months following that for the life of this permit, a monitoring/progress report including site/location map must be submitted to the Executive Director Heritage Victoria for approval.
- 4. If additional site works are required through the report submitted at condition 3, which are in accordance with the intent and approach of the endorsed documentation, supporting documentation/maps must be prepared and submitted to the Executive Director, Heritage Victoria for approval. Once approved the documentation will be endorsed and will then form part of the permit.
- 5. If any potentially significant historical archaeological features, deposits and/or artefacts are uncovered at any time during the works, activity must cease and Heritage Victoria must be notified immediately. In this case a program of investigation, excavation, recording, reporting and artefact management may be require to the satisfaction of the Executive Director, Heritage Victoria. If the Executive Director, Heritage Victoria determines that the discovered historical archaeological remains are of a high level of cultural heritage significance, their retention may be required. All on-site workers and contractors must be informed of this requirements (and suitably inducted).
- 6. The Executive Director Heritage Victoria must be informed when the approved works have been completed.
- 7. The works approved by this permit must be carried out in their entirety unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Executive Director Heritage Victoria.

NOTE THAT PERMISSION HAS BEEN GIVEN FOR INSPECTIONS OF THE PLACE OR OBJECT TO BE UNDERTAKEN DURING THE CARRYING OUT OF WORKS, AND WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS OF NOTIFICATION OF THEIR COMPLETION.

TAKE NOTICE THAT ANY NATURAL PERSON WHO CARRIES OUT WORKS OR ACTIVITIES NOT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PERMIT OR CONDITIONS IS GUILTY OF AN OFFENCE AND LIABLE TO A PENALTY OF 120 PENALTY UNITS (\$22,190.40 FROM 1 JULY 2022) OR IN THE CASE OF A BODY CORPORATE 600 PENALTY UNITS (\$110,952 FROM 1 JULY 2022) UNDER \$104 THE HERITAGE ACT 2017.

WORKS UNDERTAKEN WITHOUT A PERMIT OR PERMIT EXEMPTION CAN INCUR A FINE OF UP TO 4800 PENALTY UNITS (\$887,616 FROM 1 JULY 2022) FOR A NATURAL PERSON OR 5 YEARS IMPRISONMENT OR BOTH AND UP TO 9600 PENALTY UNITS (\$1,775,232 FROM 1

JULY 2022) IN THE CASE OF A BODY CORPORATE UNDER SECTION 87 OF THE HERITAGE ACT 2017.
