Part 2—Vision statement, objectives, principles, and statements of policy principles, Division 2—Transport system objectives

13 Safety and health and wellbeing

- (1) The transport system should be safe and support health and wellbeing.
- (2) Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), the transport system should—
 - (a) seek to continually improve the safety performance of the transport system through—
 - (i) safe transport infrastructure;
 - (ii) safe forms of transport;
 - (iii) safe transport system user behaviour;
 - (b) avoid and minimise the risk of harm to persons arising from the transport system;

Part 4A—Head, Transport for Victoria

64B Object of the Head, Transport for Victoria

The primary object of the Head, Transport for Victoria is to coordinate, provide, operate and maintain the public transport system and the road system consistent with the vision statement and the transport system objectives and includes the following—

- (e) to improve the safety of the public transport system and the road system for the users of those systems.

Part 4A—Head, Transport for Victoria

64C Functions of the Head, Transport for Victoria

- (1) The functions of the Head, Transport for Victoria are to—
 - (f) develop and implement operational policies, strategies and plans to improve—
 - (iii) the safety of the road system, including through works to improve the safety of road and road-related infrastructure;
