## **REASONS FOR REFUSAL:**

- If the application was approved, it would result in unacceptable and irreversible detrimental impact on the cultural heritage significance of the place and the Paterson Street terrace row.
- The construction of a two-storey extension including a roof lantern and the associated demolition would adversely affect the cultural heritage significance of the place and the terrace row because it:
  - Adopts a design which is unsympathetic to the character of the original dwelling.
  - Is visually overwhelming and detrimental to the setting and scale of the dwelling and terrace row; and
  - Erases the views and legibility of the form and function of the rear of the dwelling and the second chimney and hearth.
- If the application was approved, it would result in an undesirable precedent for the Paterson Street terrace row and other registered terrace rows.
- Refusal of the proposal would not prevent the reasonable or economic use of the place. It has
  not been demonstrated that an owner could not reside at the place without the level of change
  proposed.
