Re: Permit application P41205 – Queen Victoria Market place making installation

Events 720 have prepared the following drawings for the proposed placemaking installation.

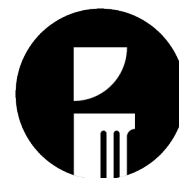

As discussed in the HIS, the proposed placemaking installation will have a negligible impact on cultural heritage significance as the proposed design is sympathetic to the cultural heritage significance of the place. The installation would be a fully free-standing galvanised steel structure supported by eight concrete-filled planter boxes, weighing approximately 1400kg each to provide stability and structural strength. The planter boxes will stand on fully adjustable feet so they can be levelled to allow the structure to work on uneven ground. The umbrellas will be suspended from a cable system attached to the supporting frame and be suspended at minimum height of 3m above the ground to ensure adequate clearance and safety. The umbrellas would be around 1.2m in diameter and installed at a slight angle to provide suitable overhang and improved coverage.

The installation is fully reversible and can removed in future without impacting significant fabric. The proposed design is also versatile, in that the hanging umbrellas could be easily changed for other items during festivals and special events or even swapped for plants in the future to increase urban biodiversity.
